Orienteering in Normandale

Orienteering Hutt Valley (OHV) ran an orienteering event at Jubilee Park on the evening of Wednesday 24 February as part of the College Sport Wellington summer series. The event was also open to the public, and we had 94 competitors of whom around 50 were school students.

Orienteering is a sport which takes you to places that you may not otherwise go to. OHV has all of the Hutt Valley mapped and we try to spread our events around, mainly to add variety and also so that competitors don't become too familiar with the map.

The last time we used Jubilee Park was November 2016, when we started on the other side of the motorway. This time we started from the small grassed area above the park, on Normandale Rd. This made for a steep uphill finish, but it meant that both courses could criss-cross the tracks and terraces below (where grand houses once stood) to good effect. There was a control on an old stone chimney, a wall which was once a swimming pool, and another which was a fernery.

Although our competitors would have been running (or walking at their best pace) hopefully we have taken them somewhere they haven't been before and they will come back at another time and take time to explore the park fully
