Hutt City Emergency Response Team

At the last NRA annual general meeting, we had a presentation from The Hutt City Emergency Response Team (HCERT). HCERT is the Hutt City's volunteer rescue response team. Established in 2006, they are now based at the Hutt City Council. The team responds to Civil Defence emergencies and other incidents on request. They are also used across the country for Civil Defence emergencies. The team work closely with Wellington's local authorities and New Zealand's professional emergency services including Fire, Police and Ambulance services.

The team consists of approximately 20 volunteers from a variety of occupations and backgrounds. They train Monday evenings on a fortnightly basis. Periodically training is also conducted during the weekends in all types of conditions so the team's commitment is impressive.

The training activities include:

- Urban search and rescue techniques
- Flood and storm rescue and swift water rescue
- Chainsaw use
- Communications
- Incident management
- 4 Wheel driving

- NZ Police;
