• All signs design and layout complete. Two quotes obtained for production and installation.

Specifications: A1 size Landscape digital print on aluminium composite board with anti graffiti overlayer. To be installed between 2 100 x 100mm posts with top of board at 1700mm. Post to be concreted in with 1/3rd in ground.

HCC

- Draft strategy documents from HCC on environment and sustainability; and Significance and engagement received with only 7 days to respond. I was unable to respond to either within this time frame on behalf of the NRA. However I believe all the points we would have wished to raise were covered in submissions completed on behalf of the Western Ward Committee.
- HCC have also notified a draft document on Residential growth which concentrates on the central city, but whose outcome could affect the relevance of proposed changes to the peri urban environment under the 'Urban Growth Strategy' so I believe we should put in at least a minimal response to give us the opportunity for further comment later. Response due by 12th Dec.

GW Draft Natural Resources plan also out for consultation.

• At first glance this seems to be almost exclusively aimed at coastal and water issues, but will look more closely and advise.
