# Issues identified at February Meeting of the Normandale Residents Association

## Jubilee Park

- Potholes in carpark asphalt
- Amount of rubbish on bottom path and pond area which needs cleaning out
- Graffiti on park signage
- Paths need more gravel as they are getting wet and slippery
- Roses and other specimens getting overgrown and need clearing of weeds
- Can pond be reinstated
- Conditions of chimney

#### Normandale Entrance

- Spraying of weeds
- Weed eater on tradescantia spreading it after it has been cleared and needs a better method of eradication
- Landscaping where trees removed cnr Normandale and Miromiro roads
- <u>St Johns steps</u> base of steps drain needs clearing it goes under step and close to that 4 inch drain approx. 10 metres uphill under the footpath which blocks, and footpath gets slippery
- Will Council provide seat to replace one that was once there. Association prepared to install it.
- Can trees be cut back to give some light and view from seat position.
- <u>Greenaway</u>-what is happening here we have had no consultation

• Condition of field is quagmire – renders it virtually unusable
