Working Bee and Planting

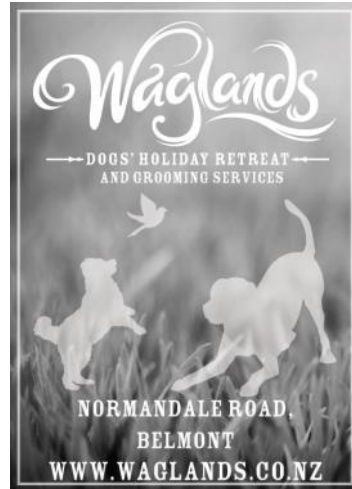
