

Pekanga Rd Playground Update




Work on refurbishment of the Pekanga Road childrens playground has progressed significantly, with the old play equipment removed and new equipment installed. New suitable ground cover has also been laid down. New perimeter fencing will be installed to prevent children darting onto the road. Large trees and vegetation previously adjoining the play area has also been cut back, increasing the usable area and providing more natural sunlight.
