


## Normandale paths, tracks, and shortcuts

Well it is actually the start of a path that leads to Wisteria Grove in Maungaraki. It is a properly formed pedestrian path with concrete paving and street lighting, in a zigzag configuration with quite a reasonable gradient and traverses some native bush.
