What is the Inorganic Collection?

Inorganic Collection Day has been a long term tradition in the Normandale community hosted by the Normandale Residents' Association.

Two Jumbo sized bins are positioned outside a communal area in Normandale where Normandale residents can dispose of their inorganic rubbish. Volunteers are there to help provide assistance transferring the rubbish.

Do I have to pay to use the bins?

As council tip fees have increased considerably, to cover our costs we would have to have a charge.

Large loads would be charged by volume, and if the committee consider the volume or type as business waste it would be charged at commercial rates.

Inorganic Collection Day is a service only extended to Normandale residents who are paid-up members of the Normandale Residents' Association (see next page).

What can I put in the bins?

Inorganic Collection Day is provided as one of the services for the Normandale community in disposing of household items too big to go in your red top rubbish bin. Anything that can be put in the recycling bin won't be accepted.

Help make Inorganic Collection Day happen - volunteer!

We cannot host events like this without volunteers from the community. Please let us know if you would be able to help out, even if it is only for an hour or two.
