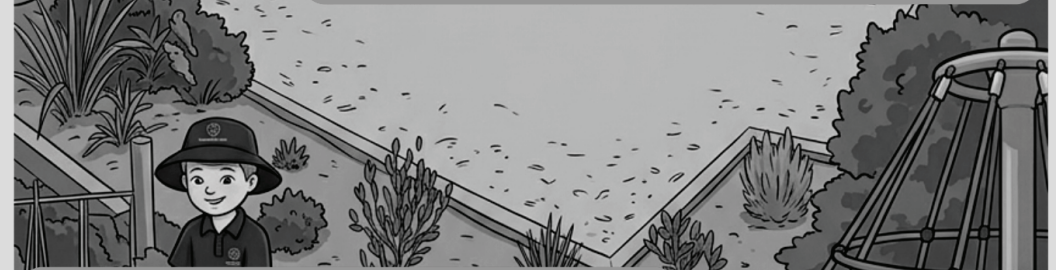

Do you have a child starting school in 2026-2027? To help with our planning please enrol them now.

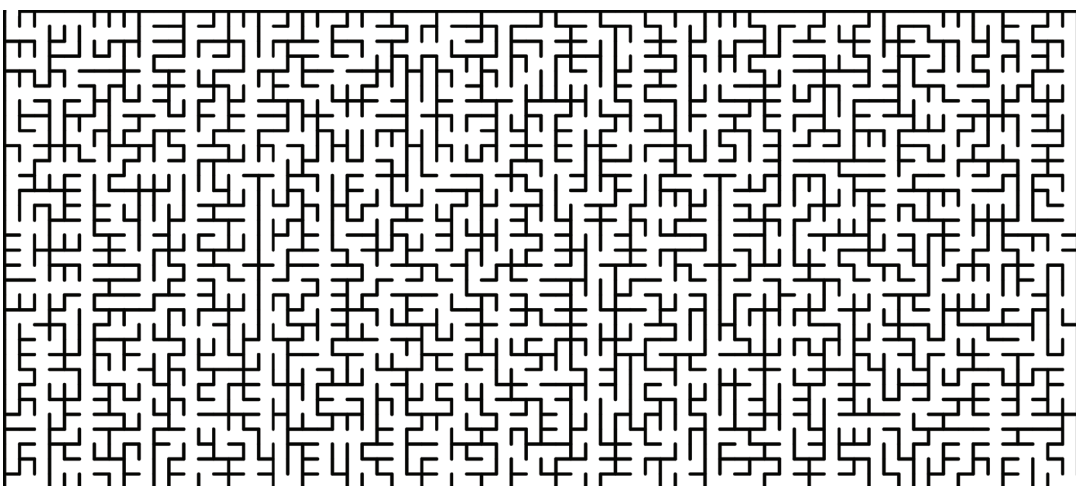

REMINDER- USE OF THE BINS

For residents who have prepaid their annual subscription of \$10 (per household) use of the bins is free. Otherwise, use of the bins is at least \$10 on the day. For large/multiple loads an additional charge may be requested.

If you haven't paid your subscription since last July, please remember to pay. Paying in advance makes it easier for volunteers at the bins, and will make it quicker to leave your rubbish and get on with your day.

What is an annual subscription? A Normandale Residents' Association subscription runs from July to June. It helps the Association with the various functions we run and work we do- Inorganic Collection Day included. When paying for a subscription, please provide your name, address, and if room an email. This will only be used if we have a question about your membership, never for spam.

Subscriptions are \$10 per household, and can be paid using online banking.
