## Past President: Sherril McNabb

I moved to Normandale with my husband Bruce and 6 (soon to be 7) children in 1987. We were enthusiastically received at Normandale School when we enrolled our primary school aged children as the roll stood at 90 at the time. For our first few years in Normandale I was a fulltime mother.

When our youngest child started school I began working as a volunteer cataloguing and classifying new books as they came into the library at Normandale School from 1992 – 96. Lwas a member of the Normandale School Board of Trustees from 1993 – 1995 and went on to become a BOT member at Hutt Intermediate.

Lioined the Normandale Progressive Association, as the NRA was then known, about 1995, and became Editor of the Normandale Times in 1996 – a position I held for 10 years.

I was President of the NRA from 2002 – 2005 when I stepped down to begin preparing for our move to China. I was also the NRA representative on the Minoh House Committee in 2006.

On our return in 2008 I did not re-join any committees as I wanted to concentrate fully on landscaping our property and refurbishing the house ready for sale. I did however take a small part-time job as a Toy Librarian at the Lower Hutt Toy library. Doing up the house took far longer than we thought but eventually we were on our way up North to Kaikohe where we are now settling in.

I hope that I will enjoy living in Kaikohe as much as I enjoyed living in Normandale, and fully intend to take part in the local community.
