### Recent events

You'll have seen the big slips that came down during the weekend of 16<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> of September, 2016. It was a pretty wet weekend. According to the metservice, (see [metservice.com/towns-cities/wellington/lower-hutt](http://metservice.com/towns-cities/wellington/lower-hutt)) in Lower Hutt we had **30.4 mm**, **27.8 mm**, and **31.4 mm** respectively on the 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, and 18<sup>th</sup> of September - a **total** of nearly **90 mm** over 3 days. This is much higher rainfall than our historical average for the whole month of September of **40 mm** ([myweather2.com](http://myweather2.com))

As a hilly suburb we should watch out for slips and drive and cycle carefully, especially after days of heavy rain like we had in the middle of September.

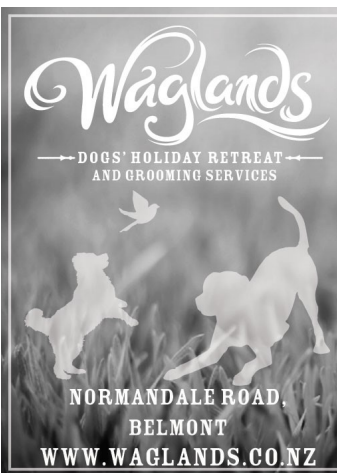
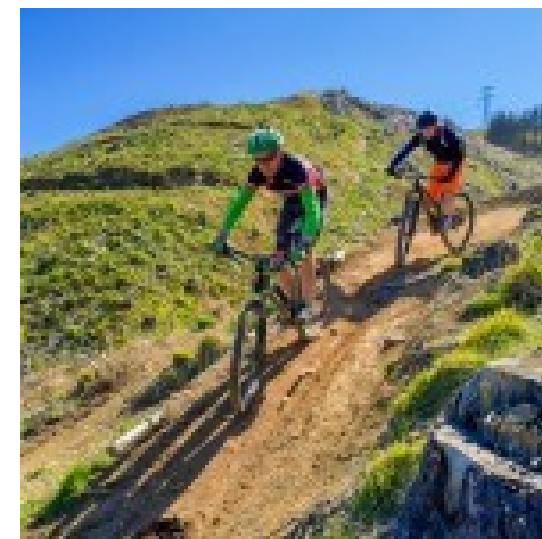
## Mountain Biking – Intro to BAMBA

The Belmont Area Mountain Bike Assn (BAMBA) has played a key role in mountain biking in Belmont Regional Park, working with Greater Wellington as a partner in building and maintaining off-road trails, and in promoting and enabling the sport.

Track identification is important, and while most tracks are for shared use, signage is used where appropriate to show that mountain biking is the predominant use. A good example of the value BAMBA adds is that since the felling of the Danzig Forest (also known as the Pine Block), the association has built many trails that climb from the bottom end of Stratton St through to Hill Rd.
